

Cookies Policy for DoxyChain

1. Policy objective

This Privacy Policy is an expression of concern for the rights of persons using the services, information and other materials offered by DoxyChain Sp. z o.o. with its registered office at ul. Prosta 20, 00-850 Warsaw which is the Administrator of your personal data.

2. Definitions

Person means – an identifiable natural person.

GDPR – Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016. on the protection of natural persons in relation to the processing of personal data and on the free transfer of such data.

User – the person using the resources of the DoxyChain Service.

Administrator – DoxyChain sp. z o.o.

Personal data – information about an identified or identifiable natural person.

Processing entity/Processor – a natural or legal person who processes personal data on behalf and for the benefit of the controller. The principles of data processing are described in the personal data processing agreement the personal data concluded between the controller and the processor.

Processing – an operation or set of operations which is performed upon personal data, whether automated or non-automated, such as collection, recording, organisation, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, matching or combining, restricting, erasing or destroying.

Cookie – information stored by a server on a user's computer, which the server can read when the user reconnects to the Website from such a computer.

System log/log – information that the user's computer sends to the server during each.

It may contain various data (e.g. IP number), from which it is possible to determine where the connection comes.

IP address – an individual number usually assigned to each computer connected to the Internet. IP number can be permanently assigned to a given computer (static) or assigned to a given connection (dynamic).

SSL protocol – a special standard for data transmission on the Internet, in which the transmission is encrypted, as opposed to normal transmission, where the transmission takes place in open text.

3. Basic IT security measures

The Administrator shall apply technical and organisational measures to protect data against loss destruction, disclosure, access to them by unauthorised persons:

- the personal data collected by the controller shall be accessed only by persons authorised to process the data, persons who have been granted the relevant powers of attorney,
- in order to ensure adequate protection of services provided by electronic means a high level of security is used, including cryptographic protection of personal data transmission personal data (SSL protocol).

4. Cookies and links to other sites

DoxyChain uses "session" cookies (saved until you leave the website, close browser) and permanent cookies (stored on your computer for a specific period of time). They usually contain the name of the originating website, the length of time they are stored on the terminal equipment and unique number.

Users can change their settings in this respect. Your Internet browser allows you to delete and block files. Detailed information in this regard is contained in the documentation of the respective web browser.

Disabling cookies will usually result in limiting or blocking some functionality of the website.

The information contained in cookies stored in Users' devices, is used for statistical purposes to illustrate the use of DoxyChain, adjustment and optimisation of the website to the needs of Users and other persons using the Service, creating statistics of viewing sub-sites of the Service.

All announcements, commercials or other similar content placed on the Website are informational purposes only, do not constitute an offer within the meaning of the Civil Code and may not constitute the basis for any claims against the Administrator.

In addition to cookies, the Administrator may also use other technologies and technical solutions that allow access to information stored on an end device, the operation of which is advantageous to the functioning of DoxyChain.

DoxyChain uses external cookies for the following purposes:

- automated logging in or registration for DoxyChain by means of a designated external service (e.g. Google),
- gathering general and anonymous statistical data through analytical tools,
- presentation of multimedia content on DoxyChain websites which are downloaded from an external website,
- use of interactive features to facilitate communication or publicity DoxyChain through utility and social networking services,
- presentation of the opinions and content on DoxyChain pages which have been downloaded from an external website.

DoxyChain uses third parties analytics software such as: Google Analytics, Google Optimize, Facebook Pixel, LinkedIn Insight Tag, Hubspot Tag, Google Ads that place data on the User's terminal device to collect information about Users.

5. Cookies policy changes

The Administrator of the Website claims the right to change the above Policy and at the same time undertakes to immediately publish the changes on the Website and to inform all the registered Users about them.

The Administrator claims the right to make changes, withdraw or modify the functions or features of the Website, as well as to cease operations, transfer rights and perform other activities in accordance with the regulations law.
